

# AFTON MENS' LEAGUE

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Starting Monday, June 6th

☞ The goal for each twosome is to beat a target of 36 points, and the pair who exceeds that goal by the most is the winner.

☞ Every golfer begins with a certain amount of points determined by course handicap. Let's say your combined 9-hole course handicap is 10; then 10 is your starting amount of points. You tee off No. 1 with 10 points. If you both par the first hole, you earn 4 points, and now you're at 14. And so on.  
Eagle: 8pts Birdie: 4pts Par:2pts Bogie:1pt

☞ Each round of mens' league will start on **Monday and run one full week**. Players can log their round any time during that week as long as they declare their intention to do so with the pro shop attendee, play the same nine established for that week, and pay **\$5 each for the pot**.

☞ Winning twosome for each round will be declared and posted in the pro shop each Monday morning during the season and **earn payout** from that week's pot total.
